

Earl Gee graduated with distinction from the Art Center College of Design, Pasadena, in 1983. He held design positions at Landor Associates, San Francisco, 1983, and Mark Anderson Design, Palo Alto, 1984. With partner Fani Chung he established Earl Gee Design, San Francisco, in 1993, a multi-disciplinary design consultancy doing identity programmes, marketing and sales collateral, product packaging, annual reports and environmental design for high-technology publishing, financial and arts organizations. Clients include: Apple Computers, Chronicle Books, Stanford University, Federal Reserve Bank, and S.F. Arts Commission. He served on a UN-sponsored delegation for package design touring the People's Republic of China in 1990. He received awards from AIGA, American Center for Design, New York ADC, TDC and Society of Publication Designers. His work has been exhibited internationally and is represented in the permanent collection of the Library of Congress.

Earl Gee schloss seine Ausbildung (1980-83) am Art Center College of Design in Pasadena mit Auszeichnung ab. Danach war Gee als Gestalter für Landor Associates, San Francisco und Mark Anderson Design, Palo Alto, tätig. Zusammen mit Fani Chung, einem jungen Yale-Absolventen, gründete er 1993 «Earl Gee Design» in San Francisco. Für Organisationen aus dem Bereich von Finanz und Wirtschaft, Kunst und Bildung werden in seinem Büro u.a. Corporate Identity Programme, Jahresberichte, Werbematerial und Verpackungen gestaltet. In den Kreis der Auftraggeber gehören Apple Computer, Sun Microsystems, Stanford University, Federal Reserve Bank und Chronicle Books. 1990 gehörte Gee zur Delegation von Verpackungsdesignern, die von der UNO gesponsert, die Volksrepublik China bereisten. 1986 gewann Gee den Silver Award des ADC (NY), 1991 den Silver Award der TIA, 1989 den Gold Award und 1993 den Silver Award des ADC San Francisco.



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



